Cascade Surgicenter Pediatric Patient Pre-Operative Instruction Sheet

The following instructions are very important for a successful outcome of your child's surgery. Have it handy when the pre-op nurse calls you, so you can fill-in the blanks. Please follow these instructions closely and call the pre-op office at 541-322-2397 if you have any questions.

- A nurse will call you with your arrival time one business day prior to your surgery, between 3:00 and 4:30 p.m. Please call (541) 322-2395 if you have not heard from us by 4:30 p.m.
- Do not allow your child to eat or drink ANYTHING after midnight. Do not allow them to chew gum or candy on the day of surgery.
- Your child may brush their teeth any time prior to surgery (swish and spit out without swallowing).
- Bring the following items for comfort: blanket, stuffed animal, iPad, favorite toy, or books.
- Please bring the following items if needed: snack, if your child has a gluten allergy and asthma inhaler if he or she uses one.
- Cascade Surgicenter is located on the lower level of THE CENTER. Please park in the underground parking lot area (accessed from the west side of the building; go down ramp). Come through doors on underground level. The check-in desk is located on the left side of the waiting room.
- Please notify **Cascade Surgicenter** at 541-322-2395 or your surgeon at 541-382-3344 if your child develops a sore throat, fever, or illness. This is an elective procedure and the surgery could be cancelled if your child is ill.
- **As your child is under the age of 18, at least one legal guardian must stay in the building at all times.**
- Limit family members: 2
- Have your child wear loose fitting, comfortable clothing, such as two-piece pajamas. He/she will be able to leave the bottoms on for surgery and will replace the top with a surgery gown.
- Bring legal guardians driver's license or photo ID, insurance card, and co-payment.
